




### STITCHED BUCKLES COMMON USE: STANDARD (SINGLE SIDE) BELTS

This is the most common belt, where the buckle is folded and then secured by stitching.



### ANCHOR (SNAP-ON) BUCKLES COMMON USE: REVERSIBLE BELTS

It is fastened by inserting the strap onto the buckle back loop and securing the pin in the buckle hole.







### CLIP ON (CLAMP) BUCKLES COMMON USE : REVERSIBLE and STANDARD (SINGLE SIDE) BELT

The clamp buckle uses a piece (with rotating mechanism in reversible belts) with teeth to clamp onto the end of the belt.

## SCREW - IN BUCKLES COMMON USE : REVERSIBLE and STANDARD (SINGLE SIDE) BELT

The screw-in buckle uses two or more screws to secure the buckle onto the belt.



# SCREW-HOLD BUCKLES COMMON USE : STANDARD (SINGLE SIDE) BELTS

This belt, commonly used by Designer Brands, features an open end which is cut-to-size and then secured to the buckle by one or more screws.



# PRESS-STUD BUCKLES COMMON USE: STANDARD (SINGLE SIDE) BELTS

This belt type is very similar to the stitched buckle with the exception that the detachable buckle is folded and secured by press-studs.
